2) Address of the Society : Chidri Road, Ram Nagar, Bidar, Karnataka State
3) Area of Operation : The Entire Karnataka State.

4) Aims and Objectives:

1. To start and run all types of the Educational Institutions i.e. Schools, Colleges, Hostels, Adult Classes, Ashrams/Destitute Homes, Children Homes, Old Age Homes, Women Welfare Centres , all types of Training Institutions, Reading Rooms, Libraries, Fine Arts, Music/Dance Institutions, Vocational Training Institutions, Medical, Dental, Engineering, Polytechnic, Nursing, Para Medical Course, Agriculture, Forestry, Environment Colleges, Computer and International Technology.
2. The main objectives of this society is to work for the utmost development of human beings irrespective caste and creed etc. through creating an awareness in Social, Education, Scientific, Economic, Technological and Spiritual matters.
3. It constantly strives to eliminate inequality, illiteracy, superstitions, Child Labour, Ignorance, Anti-Social Feelings, Alcoholism, smoking, Chewing Tobacco and all other root causes inimical to health, society Environment.
4. To work for the formation of self help groups in rural and urban areas and to take all the activities to strengthen the SHG's like arrangement of training. Assistance in opening the bank account, training for book maintenance and bank linkage etc.
5. To provide education in poultry farming, dairy technology, sheep farming activities, Bidri Arts and allied activities etc.
6. To eradicate the social evils of the area of operation of the society by implementing of rural and urban development activities in slum areas, backward areas, for developing under government schemes.
7. To support any relief activity either directly or through organization or institutions regarding such relief.



9. 18. The Income of the society shall be utilized for the benefit of the aims and objectives of the society, it might have been derived from whatsoever source it shall not be distributed amongst the members or any other interested persons.
19. To bring the common understanding amongst the members and to bring the universal brotherhood.
20. To impart training in skills to non-student, youth and also provide the opportunities of employment, self employment etc. and to promoting awareness in social evils such as dowry, untouchability, drug addiction etc. and to rehabilitate the victims of such evils of the society and render service for the development of village women, folk, and to render services for organizing youth camps for promoting National Development and for taking up social service activities and holding of seminars.
21. To undertake such other programmes and activities as would benefit the Rural and Urban people.
22. To work for any object towards general good and welfare as determined by the society.
23. To ameliorate and advance the condition and status of destitute men and women, widow, displaced men and women folk, to grant scholarship, stipends, etc. to student and other needy persons.
24. To co-operate with or assist any other organization with similar objects.
25. To undertake rehabilitation project for disabled.


1) EXPLANATION:


- 1) Society Means : "MANAVA VIKAS KENDRA"
Chidri Road, Ram Nagar, Bidar.
- 2) Institution Means : Any Institution (Mentioned in the Memorandum of Society) establish, run a maintained by the Society.
- 3) General Body Means : The General body comprising of all the valid members of all categories under the Rules and Regulation of the Society.
- 4) Board of Management : The Board of Management constituted by the General Body of the Society.
- 5) Members means : A person who attain the age of 18 years above Enrolled as a member of the Society.

2) MEMBERSHIP :-

- a) Every member should strictly abide by the constitution, Rules and Regulations of the Society.
- b) Every member has the right to participate in all the activities of the Society in accordance with the constitution.
- c) Every member having sound mind of the age of 18 years and above and declare as a member of the Society has right to vote and who is not convicted for an offence of moral tripartite.
- d) Every member of the Society shall have the right to visiting & inspecting institutions / activities of the Society and for making may suggestions that he may think proper.
- e) The membership shall be ceased or cancelled in ASE of Death or involved in any crime or failed or to pay membership fee or absent continuously 3 meetings or involve in illegal anti-management activity.

Members once who contributed the membership / donation etc. is not refundable under any circumstances and also not entitle to transfer in the name

of any other person. However, the General Body reserves the right either to accept or reject any body's membership in all the categories with the approval of its 2/3rd members.

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3) CONSTITUTION OF THE GENERAL BODY:-


General body includes all the members of the Society.

- a) At the beginning of each financial year, the General Body shall approve and sanction of an account/funds, of expenditures for the year past in each of the Societies activities / institutions and a statement of proposed expenditure for the year to come.
- b) All questions before the meeting of the general body of the Society shall be decided by Majority of votes the President having a casting vote, in causes of quality of vote, in addition to this vote as a member.
- c) The General Body shall have the powers to bring or make any amendments to the existing rules & regulations of the Society and elect the members (Office bearers) of the Board of meeting.
- d) Accept as otherwise expressly provided herein, the whole administration Management and financial affairs of the Society shall rest in the Board of Management.
- e) General Body Meeting of the Society shall be held within one year any time subject to the urgent work by giving a clear fifteen days notice to all the members specify the nature of business of the transacted, the date time and place of the meeting.
- f) The quorum for the General Body meeting not less than 1/3rd of the total number of member shall form a quorum for the meeting of the General Body.


4) CONSTITUTION OF THE BOARD OF MANAGEMENT:-


For the Management of all matters connected with the Society there shall be a Board of Management. The Board of Management shall consist of (11) members i.e. (1) President (1) Vice President, (1) Secretary, (1) Treasurer (03) other Directors.

- a) The office bearers of the Board of Management shall be elected at the end of every year during the Annual meeting of the Society. The same member being eligible for re-election of the office members.
- b) If during the three year tenure, owing to the death or resignation of any Board of Management member the vacancy thus created shall be filled up by the Board of Management from amongst the General Body.
- c) It shall be business of Board of Management.
 - i) To sanction any funds and expenditure of the Society.
 - ii) To call at the meeting subject to section-11 of the KSR Act 1960 by giving 15/10/8 clear days prior notice in writing to all the members of the Society.
 - iii) To start, a maintain run, affiliate or incorporate all types of activities / Institution at different places.
 - iv) To publish the annual reports and accounts of the Society.
 - v) To appoint an auditor for Audit of accounts subject to section 12 of KSR Act 1960 the Board of Management shall take all necessary steps to keep property accounts of the income, expenditure assets and liabilities of the Society.
 - vi) To take every necessary legal step in the matter of Society
 - vii) To represent the Society in its correspondence with Govt. or any other institution.
 - viii) The Board of Management shall have full access to the records of the Society's activities / Institutions individually or collectively.
 - ix) The Board of Management exists for the special purpose of maintaining discipline and controlling in Society's activities / Institutions. It shall make all appointments in the Society activities / Institutions and any other matter relating to discipline. Its powers are absolute.
 - x) The rates of fees in activities / Institution / Society shall be fixed and who full also have full control over the funds and expenditure.

- xi) All questions before the meeting of the Board of Management of the Society shall be decided by majority of votes. The president, having a casting vote, in cases of quality of vote in addition to his vote as a member.
- xii) It shall be duty of the Board of Management to arrange for the collection of funds for benefit of the Society.
- xiii) The question relating to discipline in activities / Institutions / Society shall be absolutely, strictly & directly responsible to the Board of Management.
- xiv) There shall be four meetings of the board of management in a year.
- xv) Quorum for the Board of Management meeting not less than 1/3rd of the total number of members of the Society shall form a quorum for ordinary meeting of the Board of Management shall consist of more than 50% of its members & there shall be no quorum for the adjourned meeting. If any ordinary meeting has to be adjourned for want of quorum.

5) OFFICE BEARERS AND OTHER POWERS:-


The office bearers shall be elected once in three years, at the Annual meeting of the Society or at the meetings specially summoned for this purpose by a majority of votes of the Board of Management.

a. President:-

1. The President shall be the head of the Society and he shall be the over all Management and its members.
2. The President may call an urgent meetings with prior notice of 3 days in writing if there is an urgency.
3. In case of emergency take up all such steps as may be required to safe guard the interest for the Society and to report the same to the General Body / Board of Management for its approval.

b. Vice President:-

The Vice President shall not as a President during the absence / vacant of the President until election of the new President and he shall also assist the president in the work of the Society.

c. **Secretary:-**

1. It shall be duty of the Secretary of the Society to call all the meetings to issue circulars to correspond under the direction of the Board of Management and to carry out their instructions.
2. To arrange for the election of the Society and to prepare the agenda and to convince the meetings of the meetings.

d. **Treasurer:-**

The Treasurer shall arrange to maintain all accounts, receipts, accounts books like cash books, ledger and all documentary records pertaining to the receipts and payments of the sources including Bank pass book and cheques of the Society, and he shall arrange to get the account of the Society audited annually by such auditors who shall be a Auditor approved by the Board of Management.

6) **Finance:-**

The Financial resources for the objects and the activities of the Society shall raised through

1. Donation from members, public etc.
2. Loans & Grants from Govt. Banks & any other local bodies.
3. Cultural Activities etc.

All the property and funds of the Society shall belong to the Society collectively, no individually members shall have any properly right over them.

7) **Bank Accounts:-**


All Banks accounts in the name of the Society shall be operated through cheques, drafts etc. with the Joint signature of the President and Secretary of the Society.


8) **Audit:-**

- 12) Dissolution of the Kendra:-

- 13) Amalgamation:-

Regarding amalgamation and re-organisation of the Society, section 21, 22 & 23 of the Karnataka Societies Registration Act, 1960 shall be followed.
- 14) Financial Year of the Kendra:-

The year of the Society shall be 1st April to 31st March.
- 15) Working Hours of the Kendra:-

The working hours of the Society shall be from 10.00 am to 1.00 pm and 3.00 pm to 5.00 pm.

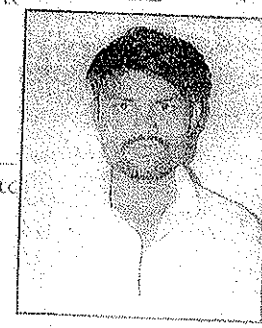
