SWARAJ VIKAS FOUNDATION established, a Self - Help Group (SHG), a financial intermediary committee consisting of 30 local women. They work and save some money for their needs. Whenever any woman need money then she will withdraw money from her savings in Self Help Group. This is highly successfully running project and we have a large no. of request to add woman in this Self Help Group. We also opened bank accounts of Self Help Group Members to maintain transparency and trust. There are following advantaged of Self Help Group: -

- An economically poor individual gains strength as part of a group. Besides, financing through SHGs reduces transaction costs for both lenders and borrowers.
- While lenders have to handle only a triple SHG account instead of a large number of small-sized individual accounts, borrowers as part of an SHG minimize expenses on travel (to and from the branch and other places) for completing paper work and on the loss of workdays in canvassing for loans.
- Where successful, SHGs have significantly empowered poor people, especially women, in rural areas. SHGs have helped immensely in reducing the influence of informal lenders in rural areas.
- SHGs help borrowers overcome the problem of lack of collateral. Women can discuss their problem and find solutions for it.

SWARAJ VIKAS FOUNDATION Conducted Covid - 19 Mask Distribution awareness, our every member of organization is distributed face mask to resident, and awareness them to among some villagers to aware for sanitation, Sanitation and Hygiene Awareness This component will target basic hygiene and sanitation behaviors at the household and community levels, including proper disposal of human waste, hand-washing practices, safe storage of water at the household level, and the introduction of dishdrying racks. We aware every age group people of complete hygiene. After that we discussed some more safety tips - Wash your hands regularly with soap and water, or clean them with alcohol-based hand rub.

- Maintain at least 1 meter distance between you and people coughing or sneezing.
- Avoid touching your face.
- Cover your mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing.
- Stay home if you feel unwell.
- Refrain from smoking and other activities that weaken the lungs.

Practice physical distancing by avoiding unnecessary travel and staying away from

large groups of people.
